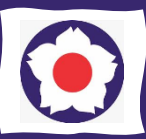

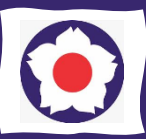

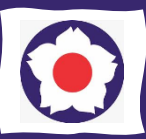

# Adjetivos comparativos e superlativos

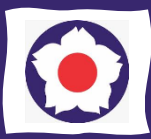
young

Matheus.*

Eloha is **the youngest**.

*Eloha é a mais nova.*



## Regra 1:

### Adjetivos curtos (até 2 sílabas)

Adj. + „-er“ than

young

Raphael is **younger than** Matheus.

big

A bus is **bigger than** a car.

sweet

Apples are **sweeter than** oranges.

the + adj. + „-est“

Eloha is **the youngest**.

A plane is **the biggest**.

Mangoes are **the sweetest** fruit.

**more + adj. + than**

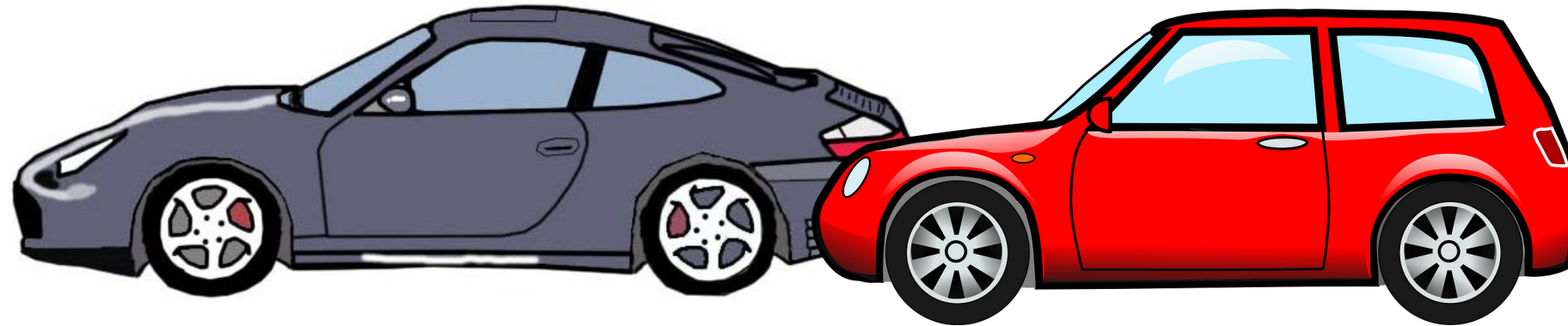
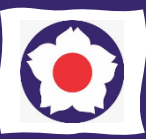

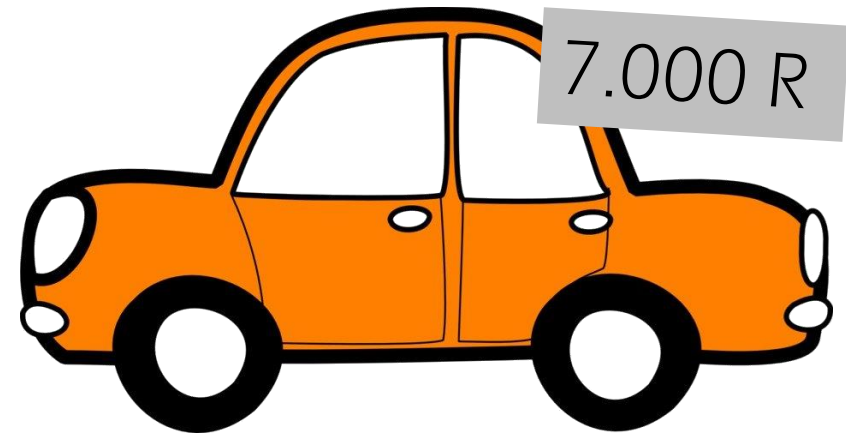
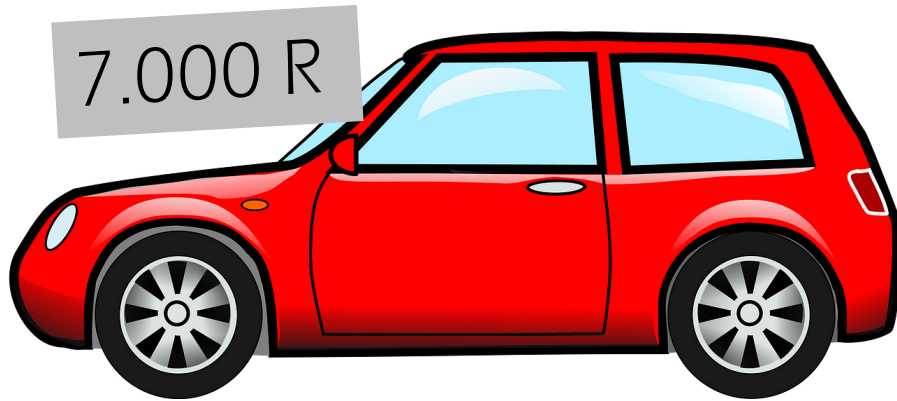
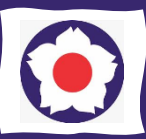


**Rule 3:**

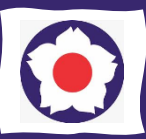

## Rule 1:

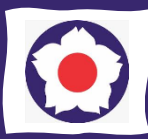
Para adjetivos curtos, adicionar um „-er“ ou „-est“ no final
