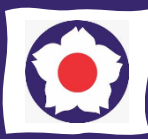

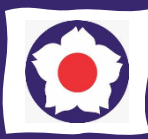
**ano:** I was born in 2000.

Exception: at night, at noon

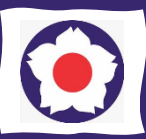


**2** É usado para indicar um local.

**país:** She lives in Brazil.

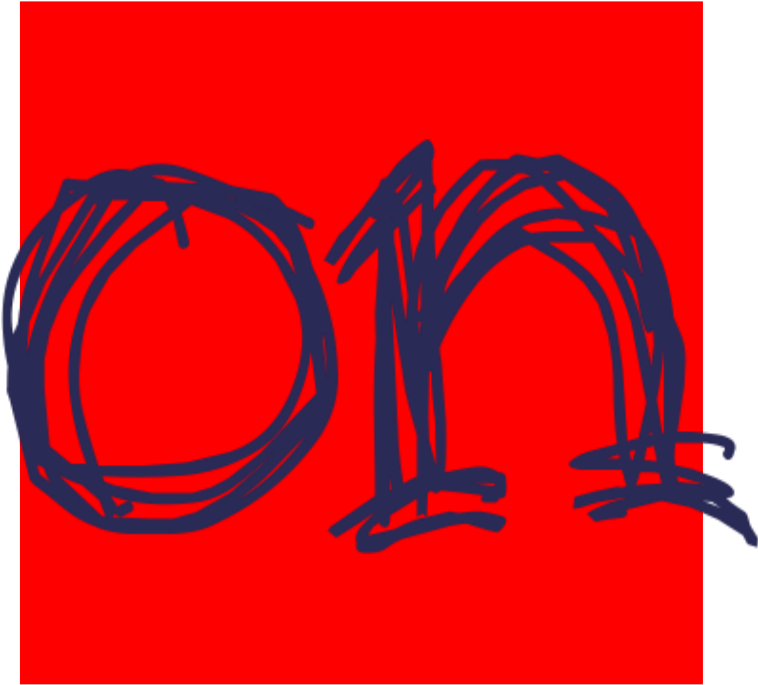
**cidade:** You are in Rio de Janeiro.

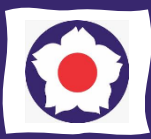
**outros:** Do you have a TV in the living room?

**1** É usado para indicar datas.



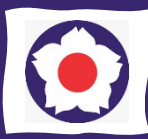
- See you on Tuesday!

- My dog sleeps on the couch.

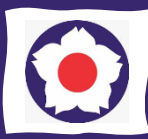


**3** É usado para indicar nomes de ruas.

**4** É usado para indicar meios eletrônicos.



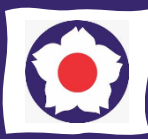
- I saw this on TV.

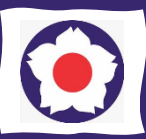
**1** É usado para indicar horários.

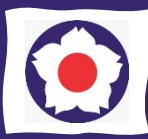
